**MINUTES OF THE MARTIC TOWNSHIP BOARD OF SUPERVISORS  
Work Session**

**DATE:** October 22, 2014

**ATTENDANCE:** Duane Sellers, Beth Birchall, Carl Drexel, Richard Drumm Jr. were present. Ted Irwin was absent.

**ORDER OF BUSINESS**

**CALL TO ORDER:** Duane Sellers called the meeting to order at 6:35 pm and led with the Pledge to the Flag.

Discussion continued on the upcoming 2015 Township budget.

Beth Birchall commented that the Township has received from the Department of Auditor General, the state supplied Fireman's relief money of \$36,317.24 which will go to Rawlinsville Fire Company.

2015 Lease agreements were discussed. For 2015, they will stay with the current lease amounts. A tenant has asked that only her name be on the next lease. It was decided that she must have her credit rechecked and if it does not come back clean, then she will need to supply another co-signer/guarantor for the lease.

Rail Trail access gates: Carl Drexel will contact Leaning Barn Iron Works to see what they will charge for the gate posts and help with installation.

RVFC has given notice that there was a last-minute training activity announced for a few of their members to attend, which took place the weekend of October 17-19, 2014. A motion was made by Beth Birchall and seconded by Carl Drexel to acknowledge this activity for the purpose of Worker's Comp insurance. The motion passed (4-0).

Duane Sellers commented that at the SLCIMC, he was asked about the pipeline Resolution that Martic passed.

Beth Birchall stated that the Township has received notice for the estimated Liquid Fuels amount for 2015 in the amount of \$198,647.17.

The next meeting of the Martic Township Board of Supervisors is scheduled for November 3, 2014 at 7:00 p.m. at the Municipal Building.

They're being no further business the meeting was adjourned at 9:00 pm.
