MINUTES OF THE MARTIC TOWNSHIP BOARD OF SUPERVISORS  
Work Session

**DATE:** September 20, 2017

**PLACE:** Township Building, 370 Steinman Farm Road, Pequea, Pa. 17565

**ATTENDANCE:** Duane Sellers, Beth Birchall, Carl Drexel and Don Snyder were present. John Ulaky was absent.

**ORDER OF BUSINESS**

**CALL TO ORDER:** Duane Sellers called the meeting to order at 6:35 pm and led with the Pledge to the Flag.

Todd Simone, asked permission to attend a course which would certified him in Environmentally Sensitive Maintenance (ESM) which is a pre-requisite to being able to apply for the Dirt and Gravel Road grants. A motion was made by Carl Drexel and seconded by Don Snyder to allow the Road Foreman, Todd Simone to attend this class. The motion passed 4-0.


Discussion began on the upcoming 2018 Township budget, with emphasis on the Road Department. Input was heard from Todd Simone, the Township's Road Foreman.

Duane Sellers and Carl Drexel commented on a meeting they had with both the Rawlinsville Fire Company and the Lancaster County Conservancy. The LCC stated that they plan on prioritizing the marking of trails, which would help emergency crews to locate lost or hurt individuals. Also, the Township has looked into the possibility of enacting a Fire Tax, since the Mud Sale and fund raisers only bring in enough money to meet operating expenses. There is nothing for equipment repairs. Duane Sellers stated that if a fire tax were enacted, the fire company would need approximately \$200,000/year and the Mud Sale and fund raising would go away. Carl Drexel commented that he spoke to Bill Regitz, who works with a company called Score. They help small businesses and non-profits work on business models. He is sure that someone from this group would be happy to come down to talk to the Fire Company.

The next meeting of the Martic Township Board of Supervisors is scheduled for October 2, 2017 at 7:00 p.m. at the Municipal Building.

There being no further business the meeting was adjourned at 8:37 pm with a motion by Beth Birchall and seconded by Don Snyder.
