MINUTES OF THE MARTIC TOWNSHIP BOARD OF SUPERVISORS
Work Session

DATE: September 23, 2015

PLACE: Township Building, 370 Steinman Farm Road, Pequea, Pa. 17565

ATTENDANCE: Duane Sellers, Beth Birchall, Ted Irwin, Carl Drexel and Richard Drumm, Jr. were present.

ORDER OF BUSINESS

CALL TO ORDER: Duane Sellers called the meeting to order at 6:32 pm and led with the Pledge to the Flag.

Discussion began on the upcoming 2016 Township budget, with emphasis on the Road Department. Comment was heard from Les Null, Township road foreman.

Doris Frey, Martic's Tax collector requested reimbursement for continuing education classes that she is may be required to take since ACT 164 has passed. It will cost approximate \$200. A motion was made by Beth Birchall and seconded by Richard Drumm to reimburse her for the cost of the classes if it is determined that she must take them. The motion passed (5-0).

Wilson Consulting Group has sent the township a proposal for the vacating portion of North Loop Road. The cost will be \$1600. A motion was made by Ted Irwin and seconded by Carl Drexel to sign the proposal. The motion passed (5-0).

Carl Drexel commented on a letter the township received from Penn Manor School District, regarding the development of a comprehensive high school master plan which will address the educational programming and facility deficiencies with the current complex. There will be a presentation on October 8th where they are seeking informal reaction to the four summary plans. Carl Drexel, Duane Sellers and Beth Birchall will plan on attending.

The next meeting of the Martic Township Board of Supervisors is scheduled for October 5, 2015 at 7:00 p.m. at the Municipal Building.

They're being no further business the meeting was adjourned at 8:34 pm.
