**MINUTES OF THE MARTIC TOWNSHIP BOARD OF SUPERVISORS**

**DATE:** October 23, 2013

**PLACE:** Township Building, 370 Steinman Farm Road, Pequea, Pa. 17565

**ATTENDANCE:** Duane Sellers, Beth Birchall, Ted Irwin, Carl Drexel, Richard Drumm, Jr. were present.

**ORDER OF BUSINESS**

**CALL TO ORDER:** Duane Sellers called the meeting to order at 6:35 pm and led with the Pledge to the Flag.

Resolution 10-23-13 which is an age corrected resolution, providing a Pension Plan and benefits to township employees passed by roll call vote (4-0) with Duane Sellers abstaining due to a conflict of interest in the fact that he is married to the township secretary.

Scott Smith presented the board with 4 quotes for a new dump truck. After much discussion, Ted Irwin made a motion to go with the Whitmoyer quote where we could order what we need, but it died for a lack of a second. Beth Birchall made a motion and Carl Drexel seconded to hold off on a decision until the November 4<sup>th</sup> meeting, which gives the insurance company time to give us a repair quote on our currently damaged dump truck. The motion passed (5-0).

2014 Budget discussion: Discussion was had on the upcoming 2014 budget.

Duane Sellers and Ted Irwin met with Conestoga representatives and Mark Wilson regarding the Trestle Bridge work to be done. Wilson Engineering is very close to putting out the bid documents for letting. The base will have wood planks; the railing proposed will be an additional 6" higher than the current required height for trails that allow bikes. The bridge will have no cross traffic; the bridge is currently set up with a middle divider, therefore all foot/bike traffic will naturally enter on the right. There will also be benches staggered along the bridge for people to stop and enjoy the view.

Beth Birchall made a motion, which was seconded by Duane Sellers to donate \$100 to the Quarryville Library in Linda Todd's memory. The motion passed (5-0).

The next meeting of the Martic Township Board of Supervisors is scheduled for November 4, 2013 at 7:00 p.m. at the Municipal Building.

They're being no further business the meeting was adjourned at 9:20 pm.
