ORDER OF BUSINESS

CALL TO ORDER: Duane Sellers called the meeting to order at 6:30 pm and led with the Pledge to the Flag.

No residents were in attendance.

Discussion began on the upcoming 2023 Township budget

Added to agenda:

A motion was made by Beth Birchall and seconded by Carl Drexel to add to the agenda Bank of Bird-In-Hand. The motion passed 5-0.

Beth Birchall commented that the Board needs to decide if the Township is interested in switching its General Fund from Truist bank to the Bank of Bird-In-Hand. Duane Sellers commented on their user friendly atmosphere. They charge no fees, which includes a scanner to deposit checks without running to a branch office, along with payroll direct deposit. A motion was made by Duane Sellers and seconded by Carl Drexel to proceed with switching to Bank of Bird-In-Hand, effective January 1, 2023. The motion passed 5-0. It was noted that making the switch date for the beginning of the year, should help the auditors with the 2022 audit.

The next meeting of the Martic Township Board of Supervisors is scheduled for October 3, 2022, at 7:00 p.m. at the Municipal Building.
