A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF MARTIC
TOWNSHIP, LANCASTER COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, AUTHORIZING
SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATIONS

WHEREAS, the Township, on December 7, 2020, adopted its budget for the calendar year 2021;
and

WHEREAS, the Township is authorized, under Section 3202(e) and (f) of the Second Class
Township Code to make supplemental appropriations for any lawful purpose from funds on hand
and to transfer unencumbered funds from one township account to another.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE AND IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED by the Board of Supervisors of the
Township of Martic Township, Lancaster County, Pennsylvania, as follows:

Section 1. The Board of Supervisors of the Township of Martic, hereby appropriates the sum of
one hundred twenty five thousand (\$125,000) dollars from account 438.45 – Tar & Chip and
place it in the newly created account 430.50 – Road Paving (non-liquid fuels).

Section 2. This Resolution shall take effect and be in force immediately.
