

## **Community Clean-up Day October 1st on the Enola Low Grade Rail Trail**

Martic Township has been working diligently to rebuild the Martic Forge Trestle nearby along the Enola Low Grade Rail Trail. Completion of that work, along with the reconstruction of the crosswalk and trail approaches at the bottom of Red Hill Road will enable a grand opening of the trestle and western portion of the rail trail. This has been a long anticipated event that will finally connect Conestoga Township through Martic Township to Providence Township and thereby open up a continuous 20 mile section of the rail trail.

The timing for all of this is late October given the current construction schedules for both the trestle and crosswalk projects. In the meantime, there is some housekeeping and cleanup needed along the trail and up to the trestle. This will involve general weeding, trash and debris removal, minor tree and brush trimming, in addition to some other tasks.

A community clean-up day is being targeted for Saturday October 1st. If you are available, willing, and able, we'd like your help in joining the cleanup crew. The goal is to make our trail clean and beautiful before opening this new section to the public.
